7. New conclusions:

Firstly, the thesis has identified the central concept of the topic: Provincial Party Committees in the Mekong Delta leading the implementation of gender equality involves the activities of the provincial Party Committee and its Standing Committee in thoroughly understanding the Party's guidelines, viewpoints, directives, and conclusions, as well as the State's policies and laws on gender equality; developing and issuing decisions and directives of the provincial Party Committee and its Standing Committee on gender equality; leading and directing the implementation; and inspecting and supervising to ensure the successful implementation of the decisions and directives of the provincial Party Committee and its Standing Committee.

Secondly, the thesis draws out specific experiences of provincial Party committees in the Mekong Delta in leading the implementation of gender equality from 2020 to the present: Provincial Party committees prioritize leadership and guidance in building and implementing coordination mechanisms among organizations of the political system in implementing gender equality.

Thirdly, the thesis proposes a groundbreaking solution for strengthening the leadership of provincial Party committees in the Mekong Delta in implementing gender equality: Strengthening the inspection, supervision, and evaluation of the effectiveness of the implementation of policies and guidelines of provincial Party committees in the Mekong Delta regarding gender equality.
