7. New conclusions of the Dissertation:

First, the dissertation systematises, supplements and refines a number of theoretical issues concerning the innovation of the modes of propaganda on Vietnam's sea and island sovereignty for university students; it clarifies the two central concepts of the dissertation: "*Propaganda on Vietnam's sea and island sovereignty for university students*" and "*Innovating the modes of propaganda on Vietnam's sea and island sovereignty for university students*"; at the same time, it clarifies the substance of innovating the modes of propaganda on Vietnam's sea and island sovereignty for university students. In addition, the dissertation also identifies the factors that impact the innovation of the modes of propaganda on Vietnam's sea and island sovereignty for university students today.

Second, the dissertation analyses and assesses the overall picture of the current state of innovating the modes of propaganda on Vietnam's sea and island sovereignty for university students in Ho Chi Minh City over the past period, drawing out certain strengths and limitations; at the same time, it identifies the core causes and clarifies a number of issues arising in the innovation of the modes of propaganda on Vietnam's sea and island sovereignty for university students in Ho Chi Minh City today.

Third, the dissertation puts forward forecasts on the world, regional and domestic situation with regard to the South China Sea issue, and proposes a system of orientations and solutions that need to be implemented in a synchronous and effective manner in order to innovate the modes of propaganda on Vietnam's sea and island sovereignty for university students in Ho Chi Minh City in the time ahead. The solutions proposed by the dissertation are synchronous, feasible and

scientifically grounded, and can be replicated for university students nationwide; at the same time, they provide a scientific basis and reference materials for the direction and organisation of the implementation of propaganda activities on Vietnam's sea and island sovereignty by Party committees, Boards of Rectors, Ho Chi Minh Communist Youth Union organisations and Student Associations of universities in Vietnam today, thereby contributing to consolidating the “all-people national defence and people's security posture” both on the ground and in cyberspace, and firmly safeguarding independence, sovereignty and strategic autonomy in defending the Fatherland in the maritime direction in all fields.
